Material: 3 mths. 6 mths.

Tencel yarn*: 150 g 200 g

Knitting needles 3,0 and 3,5 mm

Buttons

*Double: 3,5 mm/26 sts/10 cm

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MATERIALS:
FOR SIZE 6 MONTHS:

200 g Go handmade Tencel yarn
(with yarn held double)

Buttons

Knitting needles 3,0 and 3,5 mm

Gauge using 3,5 mm needles:
26 sts stockinette stitch = 10 cm

*The given amounts of yarn are for guidance only
and depend on style of knitting.*

In double yarn

**ABBREVIATIONS
AND DEFINITIONS**

N	Needle(s)
st(s)	Stitch(es)
k	Knit
p	Purl
r	Row(s)
k2tog	Knit 2 sts together
k2tog tbl	K 2 sts together through the back loop
Buttonhole	Bind off 2 sts. On next r cast on 2 new sts over the bound off sts.
Increase for raglan	Add a yarn over (yo) before and after the two k sts on the wrong side. On the right side k the yo tbl.
(..)	At the end of the line, specifies the number of sts on the needle. Size 6 months in brackets. Sizes: 3 months (6 months).



CARDIGAN - WITH FLOUNCE 3 MONTHS (6 MONTHS)

Start at the front of the cardigan.

Cast on 73 (79) sts on N 3,0.

K back and forth, in total 7 (7) r.

On the last r increase 7 (7) sts evenly; increase 1 st by lifting the horizontal strand between two stitches, then k the st tbl, in total 80 (86) sts.

Make a buttonhole. Repeat a total of 4 (5) times, with a spacing of approx. 5 cm.

Change to N 3,5, knit back and forth in stockinette. Divide the work into sleeves, back and fronts.

Increase to raglan on each side of the 2 k sts on the wrong side, on each N.

k6 (6), k9 (10), p2 (2), k10 (11), p2 (2), k22 (24), p2 (2), k10 (11), p2 (2), k9 (10), k6 (6).

The first and last 6 sts of the r shall always be knit sts (button band).

Knit until the raglan measures 11 (12) cm.

Total 16 (18) increases for a total of 208 (230) sts on the N.

Slide the sleeve sts on a new needle or a length of yarn, 42 (47) sts.

Cast on 6 (6) sts underneath each sleeve, 136 (148) sts.

Knit back and forth until the work measures 20 (24) cm.

INCREASE FOR FLOUNCE

K6 (6). Lift the yarn between each st and k tbl, finish with k6 (6).

Knit 4 cm in stockinette st, with the first and last 6 (6) sts for button bands.

Change to 3,0 mm N and knit 5 (5) rows.

Bind off from the right side.

SLEEVES

Cast on 6 (6) sts using 3,5 mm N under each sleeve, add a stitch marker.

Knit in the round with the decreases midway under the sleeve.

Knit 3 (3) cm.

k1, k2tog, k until 3 sts before the marker, k2tog tbl, k1.

Repeat every 2 (2) cm, in total 5 (6) times.

Knit until the sleeve measures 13,5 (16,5) cm.

Change to 3,0 mm N, k back and forth on both sides for 7 (7) rows.

Bind off.

Fasten all yarn ends, sew the gap under the sleeves and by the wrist.

Add buttons.

THE CARDIGAN'S FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest	52 (54) cm.
Length	25 (29) cm.
Length of sleeves	15 (18) cm.

Needle size and tension

Knitters knit very differently: some knit with a needle size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design quality as a person who knits with a needle size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of knitters who join us.

The key to knit a specific size is a lot about the knitting style/hands/skills, rather than the size of needles.

Therefore, we will recommend a range of needle sizes.



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
