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Design 07 – Lookbook 16

**PULLOVER
ECOPUNO & SILKHAIR**

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Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46, 48/50)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 250 (250, 300, 300) g of Lana Grossa **Ecopuno** (72% cotton, 17% Merino wool, 11% baby alpaca; 215 m/50 g) in Mandarine (col 72) or Neon Green (col 96) and 125 (125, 150, 150) g of Lana Grossa **Silkhair** (70% superkid mohair, 30% silk; 210 m/25 g) in Pumpkin (col 190) or Green Yellow (col 185). Size 3.5 and 4 mm needles; short size 3.5 mm circular needle.

Note: Work with 1 strand of each yarn held tog throughout = 2 strands held tog.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Rev St st: P on RS, k on WS.

Full-fashion decrease [neck shaping]: At beg of RS row, selvage st, k4, skp; at end of RS row, work to last 7 sts, k2tog, k4, selvage st.

Full-fashion decrease [sleeve shaping]: At beg of RS row, selvage st, k14, skp; at end of RS row, work to last 17 sts, k2tog, k14, selvage st.

Gauge: 18 sts and 28 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st with size 4 mm needles and 2 strands held tog.


Back: With size 3.5 mm needles and 2 strands Silkhair in desired color held tog, cast on 100 (108, 116, 124) sts. Work in St st for 4 rows, ending with a WS row. Change to size 4 mm needles. Break 1 strand Silkhair, join Ecopuno in desired color. Next row (RS): Work 49 (53, 57, 61) sts in St st, 2 sts in

rev St st, 49 (53, 57, 61) sts in St st. Cont in patt as set by last row until piece meas 28 cm from cast-on. Place marker in first and last st on last WS row to indicate beg of armholes. Cont in patt until piece meas 20 (22, 24, 26) cm from armhole markers, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders and neck: At each shoulder edge bind off 6 sts 3 times 7 sts 2 times (7 sts 4 times, 8 sts 1 time / 8 sts 5 times / 8 sts 1 time, 9 sts 4 times). **At same time**, when piece meas 1 cm from beg of shoulder shaping, shape neck as foll: Next row (RS): Bind off center 16 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 5 sts at each neck edge 2 times. No sts rem.

Front: Work same as back until piece meas 46 (48, 50, 52) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center 20 sts. Working each side separately and working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each neck edge every RS row 8 times and when same length as back to shoulders, shape shoulders same as for back. No sts rem.

Sleeves: Sleeves are picked up along armhole edge and worked down to cuff edge. Sew shoulder seams. With size 4 mm needles, 2 strands held tog and RS facing, pick up and k 74 (82, 90, 98) sts between armhole markers. Work in St st for 30 cm, ending with a WS row. Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next 7 RS rows = 60 (68, 76, 84) sts. Work 1 WS row. Next RS (dec) row: Dec 16 (20, 24, 28) sts evenly across row = 44 (48, 52, 56) sts. Drop Ecopuno, join 2nd strand Silkhair and with 2 strands Silkhair held tog, work in St st for 4 rows, ending with a RS row. Change to size 3.5 mm needles. Break 1 strand Silkhair, rejoin Ecopuno and cont in St st for 6 cm. Bind off all sts.


Finishing: Neckband: With size 3.5 mm circular needle and 2 strands Silkhair held tog, pick up and k 94 sts evenly around neck edge. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Knit 2 rnds. Bind off all sts. Sew side and sleeve seams.



Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.

beg = begin(ning) · **ch** = chain · **cont** = continue · **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) · **inc** = increas(e)(ing) · **k** = knit · **kwise** = as if to knit
meas = measures · **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop · **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop · **patt** = pattern · **pm** = place marker · **p** = purl
pwise = as if to purl · **rem** = remain(ing) · **rep** = repeat(s) · **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch · **rnd(s)** = round(s) · **RS** = right side · **sc** = single crochet · **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch · **sl** = slip · **st(s)** = stitch(es) · **St st** = stockinette stitch · **tbl** = through the back loop · **tog** = together · **wyib** = with yarn in back of work · **wyif** = with yarn in front of work · **WS** = wrong side · **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
