To achieve the best result, we recommend using Knit Pro needles, which is the professional tool for knitting and crochet.

It is a good idea to read through the pattern before starting the work, also we recommend making a swatch and wet blocking it.

There is only knitted in stockinette with ribbing edges, which are double by the front edges and around the neck.

Procedure.

Back.

- 1: On needles US 2/UK 11 cast on 90(100)110(120)130(140)150(160) sts and knit 6 cm ribbing, knit 1, purl 1. Applies to all sizes.
- 2: Change to needles US 4/UK 10 and knit stockinette, while on the first row increasing evenly spread to 110(120)130(140)150(160)170(180) sts.
- 3: Knit 26(27)28(29)30(31)32(33) cm from the ribbing edge.
- 4: Fasten off for armhole in each side 1x6, 2x3, 3x2, and 2x1 sts. Applies to all sizes.
- **5**: Work straight until the entire work measures 50(52)54(56)58(60)62(64) cm. Fasten off the middle 30(32)34(36)38(40)42(44) sts.
- **6:** Finish each side apart and fasten off toward the neck side 2x2 sts. Fasten off the remaining sts at once. Applies to all sizes. Knit the other side mirrored.

Front.

- 1: On needles US 2/UK 11 cast on 36(42)48(54)60(66)72(78) sts and knit 6 cm ribbing knit 1, purl 1. Applies to all sizes.
- 2: Change to needles US 4/UK 10 and knit stockinette, while on the first row increasing evenly spread to 46(52)58(64)70(76)82(88) sts.
- **3:** Knit until the entire work from the bottom edge measures 22(24)26(28)30(32)34(36) cm. Fasten off the following amount of sts towards the neck side:

XXS: 3x2 and 4x1 (XS): 4x2 and 4x1 S: 5x2 and 4x1 (M): 5x2 and 6x1 L:5x2 and 8x1 (XL): 6x2 and 8x1 XXL:6x2 and 10x1

(XXXL): 7x2 and 10x1

Work straight until the front piece from the bottom edge has the same length as the back from the bottom edge and to the arm hole. Applies to all

4: Fasten off for arm hole like on the back.

5: Knit until the front piece has the same length as the back. Fasten off the sts.

6: Knit the other front piece mirrored.

Sleeves.

- 1: On needles US 2/UK 11 cast on 46(52)58(64)70(76)82(88) sts and knit 6 cm ribbing, knit 1, purl 1.
- 2: Change to needles US 4/UK 10 and knit stockinette, while on the first row increasing evenly spread to 58(64)70 (78)84(90)98(104) sts.
- **3:** Then increase in both sides on every 6th row 5(5)5(6)6(7)7(7) times, then increase on every 4^{th} row 4(5)5(6)7(7)8(8) times.
- 4: When the entire sleeve measures (30)31(32)33(34)35(36) cm from the bottom edge (or the desired length) fasten off in each side 1x6,3x2 and 6x1 sts. Applies to all sizes. Knit 5(6)6(7)7(8)8(9) cm straight up. Then fasten off 5x1 and 4x2 sts. Fasten off the remaining sts at once. Applies to all sizes.
- 5: Knit another sleeve matching.

Assembly.

- 1: Sew together over the shoulder, in the sides and the sleeve hems.
- 2: Sew the sleeves on while making 4 small tucks on the sleeve by the shoulder hem. Each tuck is approx. 1 cm deep.
- 3: On needles US 2/UK 11 knit

- 330(340)350(360)370 (380)390(400) sts up by each front edge and around the neck on the back piece. Make sure to have the same amount of sts on each front piece.
- **4:** Knit 2 cm ribbing knit 1, purl 1, and make 3 buttonholes on the right front piece. The bottom buttonhole should be approx. 2 cm from the bottom edge, the last buttonhole should be where the increases for the neckline starts and the 3rd buttonhole should be right in between the other 2.
- **5:** Knit the buttonhole by fastening off 2 sts and on the next row cast on 2 new sts.
- **6:** Knit until the ribbing edge measures 5 cm. Knit one row of knit sts on the wrong side (will later be the hem).
- 7: Knit another 5 cm ribbing with buttonholes, which should be right below the other 3 buttonholes when the edge is folded and sewn to the wrong side.
- **8.** If you like you can sew a few sts around the buttonholes, so they stay put. Weave in the ends.
- **9:** Wet block the jersey. Assembly applies to all sizes.
