

1816 - Sweater with gathered top sleeve shaping in Mayflower New Sky Light.

To achieve the best result, we recommend using Knit Pro needles, which is the professional tool for knitting and crochet.

### Back and front.

Are knitted together on circular needles up to the arm holes. Cast on 192(200)210(218)226(236) sts on circular needles US 4/UK 10 and knit 2 cm in the rounds in ribbing (alternately knit 1 and purl 1). Change to circular needles US 6/UK 8 and continue in stockinette, while putting a marker in the side hems – by the beginning of the round and after 96(100)105(109) 113(118) sts. Work straight until the work measures 39(40)41 (42)43(44) cm and split it in the side hems for arm holes.

# Back.

Fasten off for arm holes in both sides on every other row 1 x 4 sts, 1 x 3 sts, 1 x 2 sts and 2 x 1 sts = 74(78)83(87)91 (96) sts. Then work straight until the arm hole measures 18(19)20(21)22(23) cm and fasten off for shoulders and neck line at the same time: From the arm hole side fasten off the shoulders on every other row with 3 x 5 sts and 1 x 4 sts (4 x 5 sts) 2 x 5 sts and 2 x 6 sts (1 x 5 sts and 3 x 6 sts) 4 x 6 sts (2 x 6 sts and 2 x 7 sts) and at the same time as the first shoulder-fasten-off put the middle 30(32)33(35)37(38) sts on a stitch holder for the neck line. Finish each side apart and fasten off in the neck side on every other row another 1 x 2 sts and 1 x 1 sts. Knit the other side opposite.

## Front.

Is knitted like the back, but with a deeper neckline: When the arm hole measures 14(15)16 (17)18(19) cm, put the middle 16(18)19(21) 23(24) sts on a stitch holder for the neckline and finish each side apart. Fasten off in the neck side on every other row another 1 x 4 sts, 1 x 3 sts, 1 x 2 sts and 1 x 1 sts. Fasten off the shoulder in the

same height and the same way as on the back. Knit the other side opposite.

#### Sleeves.

Cast on 51(51)53(53)55(55) sts on needles US 4/UK 10 and knit ribbing: 1 edge sts, purl 1, \* knit 1, purl 1, repeat from \* and end with 1 edge sts. When the ribbing edge measures 15 cm, continue in stockinette on needles US 6/UK 8, while on the  $1^{st}$  row increasing 48 sts evenly spread = 99(99)101(101)103(103) sts. Then work straight in stockinette, until the sleeve measures 44(44)45(45)46(46) cm. Then fasten off for top shaping in both sides on every other row 1 x 4 sts, 1 x 3 sts and 1 x 2 sts = 81(81)83(83)85(85) sts. From here knit in short rows like so:

- 1. r (right side): Fasten off 1 sts, knit the rest of the row in knit sts.
- **2. r (wrong side):** Fasten off 1 sts, purl all sts until the last 3 sts, turn and yo.
- 3. r: Knit until the last 3 sts, turn and yo.
- **4. r:** Purl all sts until the yo, purl the yo and the following sts together through the back loop, purl the rest of the row.
- **5. r:** Fasten off 1 sts, knit until the yo, knit the yo together with the following sts, knit the rest of the row

Repeat 2. -5. r, until you have 36 sts left (you have now fastened off  $23(23)24(24)25(25) \times 1$  sts in both sides). Repeat 2. -5. p 1 more time but fasten off 2 sts in both sides instead of 1 sts = 31 sts left. On the next right-side row knit the sts together in pairs = 16 sts. Fasten off these sts. Knit another sleeve matching.

Sew the shoulders together.

# Neckband.

With circular needles US 4/UK 10 knit from the left shoulder 17 sts up + the waiting 16(18)19(21)23(24) sts + 17 sts up along the neckline on the front piece and 6 sts up + the waiting 30(32)33(35)37(38) sts + 6 sts up along the neckline on the back = in total 92(96)98(102)106(108) sts. Knit around in ribbing (alternately knit 1 and purl 1) until the neckband measures 2 cm. Fasten off fittingly loose in ribbing.

Sew the sleeves together. Sew the sleeves on, making the top shaping gather along the armholes.
