## 1667 – Stripes women’s sweater in Mayflower Super Kid Silk.

<b>Size:</b>	S	(M)	L	(XL)	XXL	(XXXL)
<b>Chest measurement in cm:</b>	100	(104)	108	(112)	116	(120)
<b>Length in cm:</b>	64	(65)	66	(67)	68	(69)
<b>Color 14, Light Orange, balls:</b>	4	(4)	5	(5)	6	(6)
<b>Color 20, Orange, balls:</b>	4	(4)	4	(4)	4	(4)
<b>Color 01, White, balls:</b>	2	(2)	2	(2)	2	(2)
<b>Needles:</b>	Circular needles US 6/UK 8 and US 8/UK 6, needles US 6/UK 8 and US 8/UK 6. Short circular needles US 6/UK 8 for neckband.					
<b>Quality:</b>	Mayflower Super Kid Silk. 76 % Mohair, 24 % Silk, 195 m pr. 25 gram.					
<b>Gauge:</b>	16 sts x 22 rows in stockinette with double yarn on needles US 8/UK 6 5 = 10 x 10 cm.					

To get the best result, we recommend using Knit Pro needles, which is the professional tool for knitting and crocheting.

**Stripes, knitted in double yarn (= 2 treads of the same color).**

\*16 r stockinette with light orange, 2 r garter stitch with white, 2 r stockinette with light orange, 2 r garter stitch with white, 16 r stockinette with orange, 2 r garter stitch with white, 2 r stockinette with orange, 2 r garter stitch with white, repeat from \*.

### Body.

Cast on 160(166)172(178)186(192) sts with double yarn in light orange on circular needles US 6/UK 8 and knit ribbing (knit 1 purl 1). When you have knitted 12 rounds, change to circular needles US 8/UK 6 and continue with stripes, counting the first 12 rounds into the first stripe. Knit straight up until the work measures 44(44)45(45)46(46) cm and split the work at the beginning of the round and after 80(83)86(89)93(96) sts for back and front piece.

### Back.

Continue the stripes, knitting back and forth. Fasten off for arm hole in both sides of every other row 1 x 4 sts, 1 x 3 sts, 1 x 2 sts and 2 x 1 sts = 58(61)64(67) 71(74) sts. Then knit straight up, until the arm hole measures 18(19)20(21)22(23) cm. Put the middle 20(21)22(23)25(26) sts on a stitch holder for the neckline and finish each side apart. In the neck side on every other row, fasten off another 1 x 2 sts and 1 x 1 sts. Put the remaining 16(17)18(19)20(21) sts on a stitch holder for the shoulder. Knit the other side mirrored.

### Front piece.

Knit like the back, until the arm hole measures 14 (15)16(17)18(19) cm and put the middle 6(7)8(9) 11(12) sts on a stitch holder for the neckline.

Finish each side apart, while on in the neck side on every other row, fasten off another 1 x 4 sts, 1 x 3 sts, 1 x 2 sts and 1 x 1 sts. When the shoulder has the same height as on the back, put the shoulder sts knit wise against the corresponding shoulder on the back. Knit the sts together in knit sts and fasten them off at the same time. Knit the other side mirrored.

### Sleeves.

Cast on 41(43)45(47)49(51) sts in double yarn with light orange on needles US 6/UK 8 and knit ribbing (knit 1 purl 1). When you have knitted 12 rows, change to needles US 8/UK 6 and continue in stripes, counting the first 12 rows into the first stripe. Increase 1 sts in both sides of every 6<sup>th</sup> row 14 times = 69(71)73(75)77(79) sts. When the sleeve measures 44(44)45(45)46(46) cm (= same place in the stripes as the body), fasten off for top shaping in both sides of every other row 1 x 4 sts, 1 x 3 sts and 12(12)13(13)14(14) x 2 sts = 7(9)7(9)7 (9) sts. Fasten these sts off at once. Knit a matching sleeve.

### Neckband.

On circular needles US 6/UK8 in double light orange knit in knit sts from the left shoulder 17 sts up + the waiting 6(7) 8(9)11(12) sts + 17 sts up along the neckline of the front and 6 sts up + the waiting 20(21)22(23) 25(26) sts + 6 sts up along

the neckline of the back = in total  
72(74)76(78)82(84) sts. Knit around in ribbing (knit  
1 purl 1). When you have knitted 16 rounds, fasten  
off loosely on the 17th round. Fold the neckband  
halfway to the wrong side and sew it on along the  
neckline with elastic stitches.

**Seaming:** Sew the sleeve hems and sew on the  
sleeves.
